



The following are the Rules relating to National Competitions held during the **FEI European Jumping Championships (YR, J, C)**, 25th – 31st July 2016.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The Show Organisers and Directors reserve the right to reject or refuse any entry or to alter the schedule. Times and/or Arenas are subject to change. The organisers will not be responsible for any accident, damage to persons, vehicles or property.
- By receipt of your entry, the Millstreet 2016 OC understand that you further acknowledge having read the above conditions and accept the same unreservedly and understand that consent to participation in the event is only on the basis of the above conditions.
- Competitions held during the FEI European Jumping Championships 2016 will run under **National Competition** and **FEI Rules**.
- All competitors must have their horses passports at hand between 12 noon and 4pm each day. A qualified vet will carry out blood tests and random examination of horses and ponies.
- At the time of entry, full payment will be deducted from your credit card. Any outstanding balance due on your account will automatically be deducted from your credit card after the show.
- The Show Organisers are not responsible for the theft of any property or tack during the show. It is competitor's responsibility to ensure that all tack/property are kept in a safe place.

ENTRIES

- All entries must be made in advance of the closing date (15th July 2016) – Late Entries will NOT be accepted!
- Entries must be made through the online booking system www.millstreet.horse/eu2016. Entries via any other means will not be accepted.
- Entries will NOT be accepted without the accompaniment of current credit card details and payment must be in full at time of entry.
- Non runners will be refunded after the show withholding a 50% booking fee.
- The Management retain the right to refuse or accept an entry.
- Conditional Entries will not be accepted.

HEAD NUMBERS

Each horse stabled on the grounds must wear the provided bridle number at all times when outside of their stable. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.

ABUSE OF HORSE

At Millstreet Horse Show, abuse of a horse or pony is not allowed in any way whatsoever at any time. Violators may be disqualified from the show at the discretion of the ground jury and all prize monies will be forfeited. In such cases, starting and tournament fees will not be refunded. Article 243 of the FEI rules for jumping events will apply.

STABLING

- Stabling is €70 for the duration of the show. All stabling must be pre-booked and paid for through our online booking system.
- On arrival, please present your stable letter/email to management. Non-presentation may result in no access. Please have your passports ready as random micro-chip checks will be in operation.
- Owners of stallions must ensure that they bring an electric fence with them. The management reserves the right to refuse to stable a horse on the grounds.
- Please ensure that your horse/pony has up to date vaccinations.
- Stabling cancellations must be made in writing before July 15th 2016 to guarantee 50% refund. No refunds will be issued after this date.
- The showgrounds will be open from 07:00 on Tuesday 26th July. GATES WILL CLOSE NIGHTLY AT 21:00 SHARP!
- Stables will be Pre-allocated. The management reserves the right to allocate stabling and although we will do our best to accommodate special requests, they cannot be guaranteed.
- Scooters, Quads and all MPVs are strictly prohibited and will be confiscated!
- No Tents
- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
- Haylage and shavings will be available to purchase on site.
- The Show Organisers will not be responsible for any accident, theft, damage to person, vehicle or property that may occur whilst stabling on the grounds.

DECLARATIONS

Declarations must be lodged with the secretary before 6pm on the evening prior to the class.

SUBSTITUTIONS

Substitutions for national competitions will be accepted on the condition that the substitution has either the same owner or rider.

DRESS

The dress code must be in accordance with FEI Rules. Riders are required to wear numbers as provided.

STARTER

- The starter has the authority to stop any rider from entering the arena improperly dressed, without the correct number, incorrect tack etc.
- It is imperative that all riders make their way to the pocket when asked. If you are riding more than one horse in a competition, please notify the Pocket Steward before the start of the class.

LATE ENTRIES

Under no circumstances will late entries be taken for the National Horse and Young Rider Classes after the closing date.

PRIZE MONEY

All prize money will be paid in Euro. Prize money is paid by cheque drawn to the order of the account holders name and address as indicated on the online form and will be paid out after the show.

YOUNG RIDER CLASSES

Young Rider classes are open to riders under 25 years of age on 1st January 2016.

The top ten placed athlete/horse combinations in the Young Rider Qualifiers (Table A) on Thursday and Friday will qualify for the Final on Saturday 30th July.

The top four horse/rider combinations in each Young Rider Final qualify for the respective final at Millstreet International Horse Show CSI3* 2016.

HORSE CLASSES

Young Rider classes are open to riders under 25 years of age on 1st January 2016.

The top twenty placed athlete/horse combinations in the horse classes on Thursday and Friday will qualify for the finals on Saturday 30th July.

The top three horse/rider combinations in each Final qualify for the respective final at Millstreet International Horse Show CSI3* 2016.
