The parade of nations is one of the most spectacular parts of the whole week. Only the international competition course in the main area might be as colourful as this parade itself. This year, the hosts arranged something verv special: All 29 nations were led by bagpipers through the town of Millstreet. Escorted by the police and numerous press photographers, the parade was accompanied by inhabitants of Millstreet cheering for the young riders from all over Europe. The future champions were impressed by the warm welcome of the Irish people and gained even more motivation to give all of their the following in best competitions.

The first ribbon goes to Italy!

Yesterday afternoon the first official competition of the show took place in the main arena. Beatrice BACCETTA from Italy and her horse "Fanthasia" finished the first round as the glorious winners. She was followed closely by Mira HØIDAL (DEN) and Bernardo Nobre PALMA (POR).

An outstanding result was reached by last years' team gold medallist nation Germany: Four of their five riders (Piet MENKE, Flemming RIPKE, Viktoria SCHMIDT, Pia STIEBORSKY and Joan WECKE) were placed and all of them finished clear – the perfect foundation for further success!

Moreover, five competitors participated for the individual gold medal title holder nation, host country Ireland. The best result was achieved by Dan GEANEY and his horse "Coral du Carel", placed 23rd with a clear round.
