

Each Nation can put forward a team of 4 athletes & 2 Individual Competitors.

- Nominated Entries: 17 June.
- Definite Entries: 1 July



Competitors entering the Championships class are also permitted to enter classes running along side the Championship.



There will also be CCI2\*L, CCI3\*L, CCI4\*L, CCI3\*S & CCI4\*S running alongside the Championship



Competition fully live streamed worldwide



Qualification Criteria: 1 CCI4\*- S MER obtained as a combination from 1 January 2025 and the closing date of the nominated entries

The Green Glens Arena has 11 all weather Arenas both indoor and outdoor for Dressage & Jumping Tests

The Cross Country Course designed by Mike Etherington Smith (GBR) set on the scenic grounds of Drishane Castle, adjacent to the Green Glens Arena complex.

Run by three generations of the same family, Millstreet has hosted the Underage European Championships (2014, 2016, 2017), the FEI Eventing Nations Cup (2018, 2023, 2024), and a regional qualifier for the Paris 2024 Olympics in recent years – all part of its long and distinguished history.
