



Millstreet Autumn Grand Prix Show 2026

23rd – 25th October 2026

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- The Show Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry and to amend the schedule, classes, times or arenas where necessary.
- By entering, competitors confirm that they have read and accepted these Terms & Conditions, the applicable SJI rules and instructions issued by Show Officials.
- Competitors are responsible for the accuracy of all information submitted with their entries.
- The Organisers accept no responsibility for accident, injury, loss, theft or damage to persons, horses, vehicles or property, except where liability cannot legally be excluded.
- Showgrounds Opening: Thursday 22nd October 2026 🕒 Gates open at 2:00 PM – earlier arrival can be arranged by appointment at a cost of €75 per horse.

2. COMPETITION RULES

- The show will operate under the applicable **SJI National Competition Rules**.
- All horses and ponies must have valid passports and meet current vaccination requirements.
- Passports must be available for inspection at any time.
- Horses and ponies may be subject to veterinary examination, microchipping and blood testing throughout the show.

3. ENTRIES & PAYMENT

- Entries must be made through the designated online booking system and/or SJI Live, as applicable.
- Full payment is required at the time of entry. Unpaid entries may be cancelled.
- The Management reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry.
- Non-runners may receive a refund after the show, less a **€15 administration fee per entry**, subject to the cancellation conditions.

- Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Show Secretary and will incur a **late-entry fee per class**.
- Substitutions are permitted only when subject to the applicable SJI and Show rules. Unauthorised substitutions will result in disqualification.

4. CANCELLATION

- Cancellations for Stabling & Electric Hook Up must be made in writing **before 5.00pm on Friday, 9th October 2026** to qualify for any applicable refund.
- **No refunds will be issued after this deadline**

5. STABLING

- Stabling must be booked and paid for in advance.
- Stables will be allocated by the Stable Manager. Special requests cannot be guaranteed.
- ⚠ Stable Allocations: All competitors must use the stables allocated to them by the organisers. Any account holders found occupying a stable that was not allocated to the account will be disqualified from the show immediately. No refund will be provided.
- Aisles and stable doors must remain clear. Stables must not be altered, damaged or defaced.
- Large bales or any large items may not be placed in stables aisles or obstruct the passage ways.
- Stallion owners are responsible for providing suitable safety measures, including an electric fence where required.
- The Organisers reserve the right to refuse stabling where necessary for safety, welfare or operational reasons.
- Competitors must present their stable number on arrival and have passports available for inspection.

6. SHOW GROUND RULES

- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
- **Electric scooters**, e-bikes, electric bicycles, electric skateboards, hoverboards and similar personal electric vehicles are strictly prohibited on the show grounds. Any such vehicle will be confiscated by Show Management.
- Quads and unauthorised motorised vehicles are prohibited.
- Tents and unauthorised camping structures are not permitted.
- Showgrounds Opening: Thursday 22nd October 2026 🕒 Gates open at 2:00 PM – early arrival is available by appointment at a fee of €75 per horse.
- Gates will close nightly at **8.00pm**, unless otherwise advised by the Organisers.

- Competitors must comply with all instructions issued by Show Management, Stewards and Officials.

7. COMPETITION & PRACTICE ARENAS

- Riders must follow the instructions of the Starter, Ground Jury, Stewards and Arena Officials.
- Riders must proceed to the designated pocket when requested and cooperate with Pocket Stewards. Miss your turn = withdrawal from class with no refund.
- Abuse, threatening, aggressive or inappropriate behaviour towards staff, stewards, officials or volunteers will result in immediate disqualification without refund.

8. PRIZE GIVING & PRIZE MONEY

- Winners of classes must attend official prize-giving ceremonies when requested. Failure to attend may result in forfeiture of the prize.
- Prize money and refunds will be paid in Euros after the show using the payment method determined by the Organising Committee.
- Official protests must be submitted in accordance with the applicable SJ/FEI rules and procedures.

10. HORSE & PONY WELFARE

- The welfare of all horses and ponies is paramount.
- Any behaviour considered abusive, cruel, unsafe or detrimental to animal welfare will be acted upon.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to disqualify competitors or take other appropriate action where animal welfare is compromised.
- All competitors must comply with veterinary, welfare and safety requirements throughout the event.

11. PASSPORTS, VETERINARY INSPECTIONS & BLOOD TESTING

- All horses and ponies must have valid passports and comply with the required vaccination regulations.
- Passports must be available for inspection daily.
- Microchipping, veterinary inspections and random blood sampling may take place throughout the show.
- Competitors must cooperate fully with all veterinary and identification procedures.

12. PROPERTY

- The Organisers accept no responsibility for the loss, theft or damage of personal belongings, tack, equipment or other property.
- Competitors are responsible for keeping their belongings secure.

13. PROTESTS

- All official protests must be made in accordance with the applicable SJI National Competition Rules and, where applicable, FEI regulations.

14. DATA PROTECTION

Millstreet Autumn Pony & Young Rider Show will use personal information only for purposes connected with the administration and operation of the event, including entries, stabling, payments, start lists, results, refunds and prize money.

Information may be processed by appointed service providers, including **Equipe AB**, where applicable. Personal information will not otherwise be shared except where required by law or necessary to administer the event.
